

3.9 Bits

The following six categories of bits are approved for use: -

- (1) Standard bits – All ‘D’ Bits, Egg-butt Snaffle Bits and Loose Ring Snaffles
- (2) Lugging bits – Ring Bit, JR Lugging Bit
- (3) Norton bits – Norton Citation Bit
- (4) Tongue Control bits
- (5) Rubber bits
- (6) Roller bits
